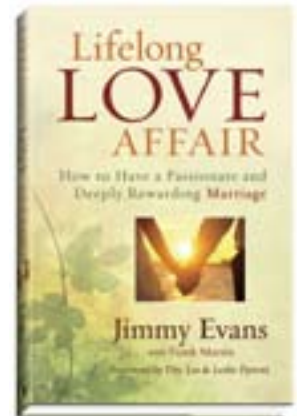

FROM THE DESK OF **MARCUS LAMB**

Dear Partners & Friends,

I have some **milestones** to share with you!

A few weeks ago was New Year's Eve, and that marked the **15th anniversary, or birthday** of your Daystar Television Network!

Daystar became a Network on December 31, 1997. At the time, we only had three TV Stations: 1) Dallas, Texas 2) Macon, Georgia and 3) Denver, Colorado. So we hooked those three TV Stations together via Satellite. The first thing Daystar broadcasted as a Network that night was the **"live"** New Year's Eve service of **Bishop T. D. Jakes** at **The Potter's House** in Dallas, Texas!

But Joni & I have been in Christian Television a lot longer than 15 years. God called us to Christian TV in March, 1983 while we were on the **Mount of Olives in Israel**. We moved to Montgomery, Alabama in January, 1984 to start building our first Christian TV Station. We later moved to Dallas, Texas in December, 1990 to start building our first Dallas Station. (The Dallas Station came on the air in September, 1993.) So we have been in Christian Television since 1984 which is a total of 29 years.

And this July will be my **40th year in ministry!** (I started preaching when I was only 15 years old in Macon, Georgia.)

## LIFELONG LOVE AFFAIR

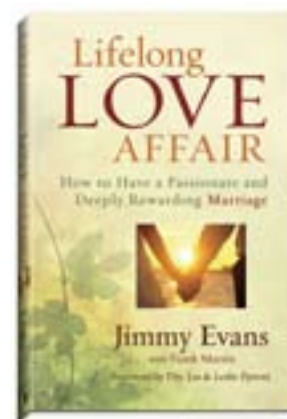
Excerpt from Jimmy Evan's newest book, "Lifelong Love Affair" - Ch. 1
