



FROM TRAGEDY TO TRIUMPH

INTERVIEW WITH DAVE ROEVER

Why did you decide to create Tragedy to Triumph?

I have been on television, off and on, for many years. But, most recently, in the past 15 years, my work with the military has skyrocketed. It has been a desire for me to get the message out to the American people relating the struggles (tragedies) as well as the victories (triumphs) that our brave men, women and families of the United States Military face day in and day out.

What is your favorite part about Tragedy to Triumph?

All of it! It's hard to single out my favorite part because whether it is an episode with me sitting with guests or just me by myself, what I know is that everything the viewer sees is real, raw, and from the heart!

In sharing your story across the country, what has been one of the most memorable presentations you have given?

God has truly given me so many great opportunities to share my experiences with the best audiences out there. I've shared one on one with President Reagan, sitting in the oval office; I've shared my story in large stadiums with 50,000 plus people; I've sat in hospital rooms with the

wounded at Brooke Army Medical Center and shared my life with a warrior who has returned home feeling helpless and hopeless; each one is memorable

in it's own special way!

How has relying on God through all the difficult times made a difference in your life today?

Hands down, I would not be here if I hadn't had faith in God! I love my wife and she was the second biggest reason I made it, but God has and continues to be my healer, my strength, my everything! I don't know where people turn who do not have a relationship with God and I couldn't go on if for any reason that was taken away from me.

Tell us a little more about Operation Warrior RECONnect. What was your main reason for starting this program, and how has it positively impacted the lives of wounded warriors?

Operation Warrior RECONnect was started in an effort to give hope to otherwise hopeless warriors. We conduct our OWR sessions at either one of our Eagles Summit Ranches, one in Colorado and one in Texas, or at various other locations we use as the need arises. During these sessions, we teach the warriors that life isn't over simply because they were injured. We equip them with the tools necessary to live productive lives. One aspect I am most excited about is we set before them examples of marriages and families that have survived traumatic injury. So many families fall apart after coming home from war and we are working hard to help them understand that their families can be saved. We have seen this lived out in the lives of these warriors who are still together as a family unit, working through the challenges and succeeding. Many of the warriors who have been through our program are out preaching the gospel, sharing their message of tragedy turned into triumph!

With the 4th of July coming up, what are some of your favorite 4th of July traditions?

Well, I have a really unique tradition. It almost always involves me traveling to some location and speaking for a 4th of July event! With my military injury and background, 4th of July, along with Memorial Day, Veterans Day and other patriotic celebrations, is one of the most sought after days on my calendar. I love it! So, while everyone else goes back to work on July 5th, that's the day I fire up the BBQ grill and go to the lake!
