God has been present in my life for as long as I can remember. I grew up in a family where it was just my Mom and me. Thus she became my example, my role model and my support in everything. I recall my first encounter with the Lord when I was ten years old. It was nighttime, and He

was standing right at the foot of my bed. I couldn't see His Face, but His Presence overwhelmed me, and I could literally feel Him looking right at me. I woke up my Mom so she could see Him, but she couldn't see him. Only I could. It was mind-blowing and wonderful.

Ever since, I've always felt Him right by me. He'd sometimes be asking me things and other times He would give me real clear instructions to follow.
