Q: Working in law and justice, where's the balance between enjoying freedom while still maintaining order?

A: We have been given many freedoms endowed by our Creator. At the same time, we are a nation of laws and our Founders wisely put in place the U.S. Constitution as the framework for our republic. At the American Center for Law and Justice, we understand that the rule of law and the Constitution must be protected at all costs. That is at the center of our work. By protecting our constitu-

tional and religious rights, we are able to safeguard the many freedoms we enjoy in this great country.

Q: From your perspective, what freedoms are currently under fire or are being infringed upon in America?

A: In a culture where so many people are deeply divided, it is becoming increasingly popular to attack free speech – to challenge conservative and religious view-

points – and clearly there's a troubling trend to eliminate such speech. I have spent my legal career – including with numerous cases before the United States Supreme Court – defending the First Amendment of the Constitution. It is deeply disturbing that so many who disagree with conservative or religious speech want to remove it from the public square. These censors want to eliminate discourse, instead of encourage it. The First Amendment is under attack right

now in cities across America, on college campuses, in the workplace, and as we see every day, in the political world. We remain dedicated to protecting the First Amendment to ensure that robust free speech and free expression continue. At the same time, one of the most cherished and a fundamental freedom – the right to life – is increasingly under attack. At the *ACLJ, we have two critical pro-life cases headed to the Supreme Court.

Q: Do you believe America's freedom of religion is being jeopardized? How do we keep this from happening?

A: I do think there's a real effort underway in this country to marginalize Christians – especially Christian conservatives. The political Left – along with a cooperating mainstream media – is intent on marginalizing Christian conservatives and their beliefs. There's also a disturbing trend to remove any vestige of Christianity from the public square. We have succeeded in many cases where atheists and others have gone to court to challenge Christian symbols publicly displayed – in some instances for more than half a century. It is important for Christians to stand-up for their beliefs – to counter the politically-correct effort underway to silence or marginalize Christians.

Q: What are some of the hot button topics currently being discussed in government right now?

A: This is a critical time in Washington - and a critical time for Christian conservatives. At the ACLJ, we're engaged in a number of vital issues that impact Christians here and around the globe. For instance, we continue to battle the genocide of Christians by ISIS. We have raised this issue at the highest levels of government - in this country and abroad. We have filed legal submissions to the United Nations. We are demanding that the U.N. recognize the atrocities and work to protect Christians. At the same time, we're engaged in other critical issues - including the defense of life by working to defund Planned Parenthood and put a stop to the hundreds of millions of taxpayer dollars that go to the nation's largest abortion provider. Further, we have seen an uptick in attacks on our national security - from classified leaks to frivolous lawsuits - all because the radical Left oppos-

es anything President Trump does - even when it is commonsense protections for America.

tections for America. Q: Where does your passion for law

and justice come from?

A: I am the grandson of a Russian immigrant. My grandfather was a fruit peddler in Brooklyn, New York. I understood at an early age that it is truly a privilege to be a U.S. citizen. We are so blessed to live in this great nation – to enjoy the freedoms and to practice our faith freely and openly.

Yet, there are so many people around the world who do not enjoy the same freedoms that we do. We must help those who cannot help themselves. That's especially true when it comes to protecting religious freedom – in this country or abroad.

Q: What is God's stance when it comes to freedom, law, and authority?

A: I believe, as did our Founding Fathers, that freedom and liberty are God-given inalienable rights. The role of Government is to protect those rights that God has bestowed upon mankind.

The Other Side of FREEDOM

In the book of 1 Corinthians, the Apostle Paul spends three chapters discussing whether or not Christians should eat food sacrificed to idols. But that sort of thing isn't an issue we have to worry about today, is it? It only applies to ancient times, right?

Not hardly.

We may not struggle with heathen food offerings today, but the principles of love that Paul lays out are timeless. As Christians, we possess many freedoms—freedom of what to eat, what to drink, when to worship, and how to dress. But did you know that your freedom ends when it causes another Christian to stumble?

Many at the church in Corinth knew they had the liberty to eat whatever they desired. However, some new converts—recently snatched from pagan idolatry—still thought Greek gods were real. When they saw other Christians eating food sacrificed to those gods, they became confused and their consciences became defiled.

So Paul commanded the mature Christians to look out for their weaker brothers. Even though they had liberty in Christ, they must not exercise that liberty if it hurt another believer. Paul practiced what he preached. In 1 Corinthians 9, we read that Paul limited himself to Jewish customs when evangelizing Jews (9:20) and to gentile customs when evangelizing gentiles (9:21). Paul became all things to all people in order to save some (9:22).

How about us? Are we willing to give up our rights in order to see people come to Christ? Are we willing to forego temporary enjoyment for eternal rewards? Love, and an eternal perspective, should motivate our exercise of freedom.
